- 1. <u>Welcome and Apologies for Absence</u> Apologies for absence were received from Councillor Kent. Councillor Leveridge was not present.
- 2. <u>Public Voice</u> No Members of the Public were present.
- 3. Declarations of Interest -
  - <u>25/01058/LBDISC Post Office, High Street</u> Councillor Killion declared a personal interest as his stepson works at The Mistley Thorn (Old Post Office).
- **4.** <u>Minutes of the Previous Planning Committee Meeting</u> The Minutes of the Planning Committee Meeting held on the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025 were received, considered and agreed following the vote. (Proposed by Councillor Walker and seconded by Councillor Cunningham).
- 5. <u>Matters Arising/Updates from Previous Minutes</u> There were no matters.

  - b. <u>25/00690/LUPROP Willowherb, 4 New Road</u> Application for Lawful Development Certificate for Proposed Use or Development for construction of a single storey garden room – The Committee noted that the Lawful Certificate has been granted by the LPA.
  - c. <u>25/00134/VOC Land South of Long Road</u> Application under Section 73 of the Town and Country Planning Act for Variation of Condition 1 (Approved Plans); Condition 2 (Internal Road, Footway, Turning and Parking Areas); Condition 6 (Cycle Parking Facilities); Condition 13 (Materials) of application 24/01181/VOC to allow design changes The Committee noted that this application has been approved by the LPA.
  - d. <u>25/00540/FULHH 5 Erskine Road</u> Erection of a single storey timber framed porch to the front elevation. Change of external wall treatment to the existing single storey rear extension from brick to render The Committee noted that the LPA has approved this.

- d. <u>25/01110/FUL 7 Harwich Road</u> Erection of MOT garage building Following the vote, no objections were raised. (Proposed by Councillor Cunningham and seconded by Councillor Walker).
- e. <u>25/01135/TCA Terrena Mill Hill</u> Trees in a Conservation Area Notification T1 T3 Conifers Trim sides and top. T4 Cherry Reduce crown by 1-1.5 metres. T5 Pittosporum Reduce in height by 1-2 metres. Prune one side back to the boundary line. Reduce remaining sides by 1 metre Following the vote, (proposed by Councillor Cunningham and seconded by Councillor Coiley), the Committee recommended that the LPA's Tree and Landscape Officer makes a decision under the LPA's scheme of delegation.
